Reforming the Volcker Rule & RIA rules to encourage VC investment (especially in emerging ecosystems across the country) are key priorities for NVCA.



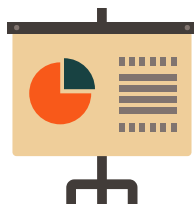
Capital Markets
