



Wraithwatch, based in Bozeman, is an advanced cybersecurity platform developed by veterans from SpaceX, Anduril, and Palantir. Dedicated to protecting U.S. interests and those of its allies, this Al-driven system proactively simulates and counters emerging Al-powered cyber threats.



MagDrive Technologies of Bozeman is pioneering advanced valve technology to combat greenhouse gas emissions. Their magnetic valve drives eliminate fugitive emissions from industrial operations, particularly in the oil and gas sector. With roots in NASA and Department of Defense projects, this company is enhancing national energy security while significantly reducing environmental impact.



LandTrust is an innovative online marketplace connecting private landowners with outdoor enthusiasts across 37 U.S. states. This platform supports rural economies by allowing landowners to monetize over 1 million acres of undeveloped land for recreation. Bozeman-based LandTrust promotes land conservation, supports agricultural communities, and expands affordable outdoor access for Americans.
